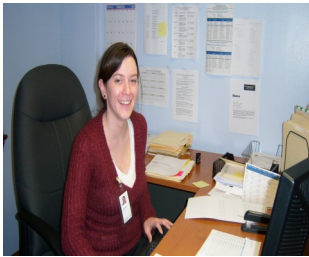

A Step Away.....

As we enter the new quarter of the year, more changes are about to happen. OFA will be relocating the CRC Program to the other elementary building on the property. (2nd. photo to the right). The building will be our Pre-placement Program, which will prepare people for employment. The other school building (3rd. Photo), currently housing the CRC Program, will become the Training Center, offering a variety of apprenticeship classes to prepare people for a specific career goal that they have chosen. Our Administrative Building, currently housed in the rectory, will relocate to the convent building (1st. Photo), directly to the right of Holy Angels Church. OFA will continue to provide employment services to referrals from both State Parole & the local DVR offices. However, we will also offer services to the Federal Program, Prison Re-entry Program, and the Another Chance Program, which is thru the Trenton One Stop Career Center. We will also offer onsite drug screening services. All of our services are literally ‘One Step’ away from each other! We are accessible to public transportation & have ample parking for all.
